

IMPORTANT GRADUATION INFORMATION

As a reminder, outlined below are the primary graduation requirements:

- 120 non-repeated/non-duplicated credits (Be aware that if you earn a passing grade in a course more than once you will receive credit for only one of the attempts. Make sure you adjust for any repeated credits when you calculate how many credits you still need to complete.)
- 32 upper-level credits (At Towson University any undergraduate course numbered 300 or higher is considered to be an upper-level course. Upper-level credits can be from **any** discipline.)
- Cumulative GPA of at least 2.0; additionally, all courses that are counted toward your major or minor, as well as Gen-Ed categories IA and ID, must be completed with a “C” (2.0) or higher.
- General Education Requirements [Core Requirements for students entering Fall 2011 or later] (Outlined in the Degree Progress Report as well as in your Undergraduate Catalog.)
- Complete at least one Major (Outlined in the Degree Progress Report as well as in your Undergraduate Catalog.)

Remember that it is YOUR responsibility to be familiar with degree requirements. Advising is intended to be an opportunity for you to have specific questions answered.

Nevertheless, YOU are expected to track your degree progress regularly; this can be done accessing your Degree Progress Report through Towson Online Services or by referring to your particular Undergraduate Catalog.
