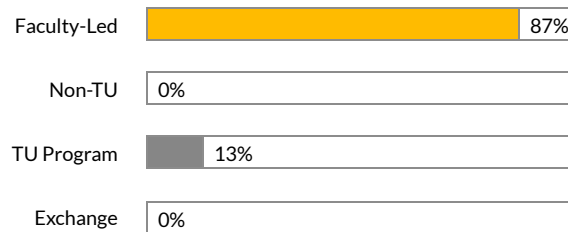

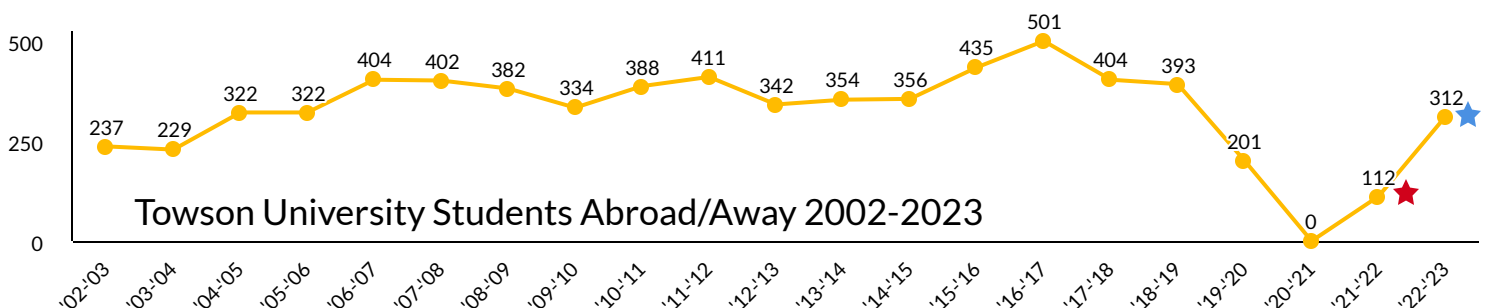

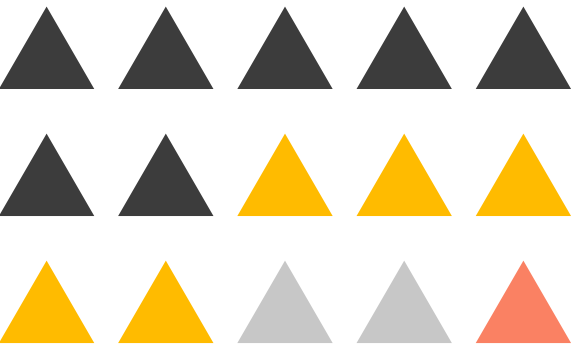
COE Study Abroad/Away by Ethnicity

- Asian (6.67%)

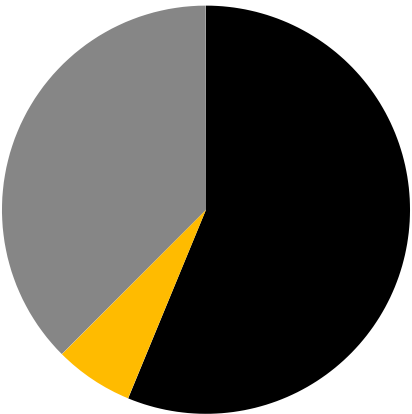
