Faculty Play an Integral Role in Course Evaluations

Here are some ideas for how faculty can make a difference in the quality and quantity of course evaluation responses.

- 1. Include course evaluations on the syllabus with the administration dates as an item for students to complete.
- 2. Allow students time in the beginning or middle of class to complete course evaluations.
- 3. Post the link to course evaluation on Blackboard and remind students during class why it is important for them to submit their course evaluations.
- 4. Explain how you have used feedback from past evaluations to improve your current courses.
- 5. Check your course evaluation response rates and send a personal email to students reminding them to submit course evaluations.
- 6. Provide a small incentive to students if your class response rate is over 90%.
- 7. Reiterate that course evaluations are anonymous. Faculty can only see what percentage of their class has responded, but they cannot see the identities of individual respondents.



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
