Admission eligibility for the entering freshman will be partially determined by the student's completion of these minimum high school curriculum requirements.

Admission decisions are rendered on a rolling basis, as qualified applicants' admission materials are received and processed. Towson University reserves the right to close admission for any term once it is determined that space no longer remains in the freshman class.
