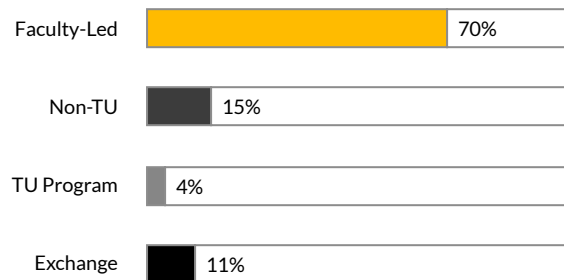

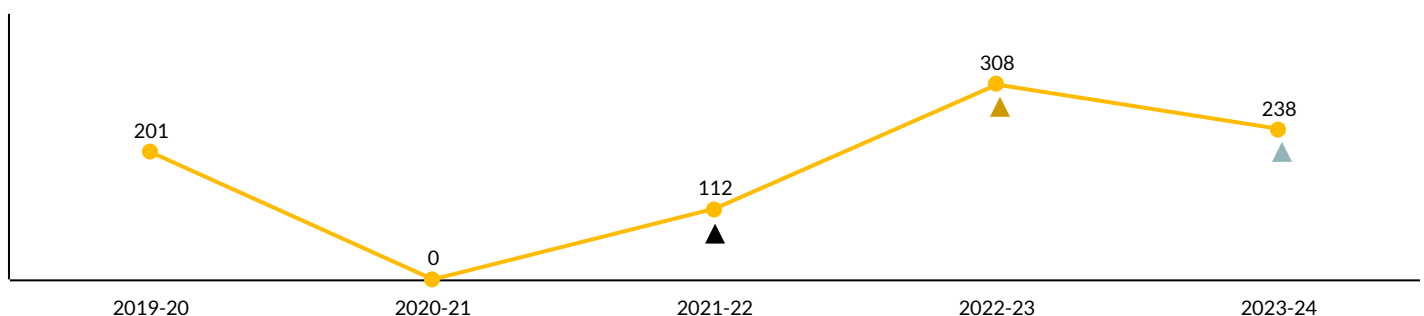

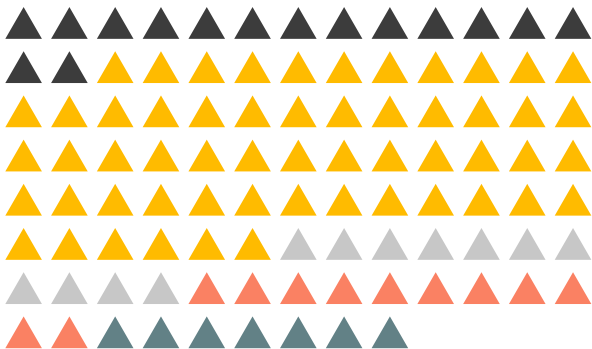
FCSM Study Abroad/Away by Ethnicity AY 2023-24

- Asian (15%)

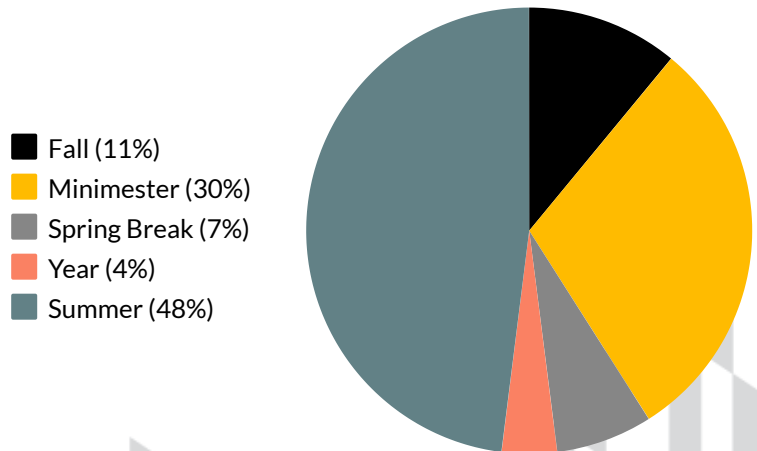
