#### **HOLISTIC REVIEW**

We seek to offer admission to students who will be successful and engaged members of the TU community. Evaluations consider high school grades, curricular options, essay and activity list. Letters of recommendation are not considered. Test scores are optional and will not negatively impact an admissions decision.
