
FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid consists of scholarships, need-based grants, loans and student employment. To apply for financial aid, students must fill out the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA deadline for TU is Feb. 1. TU's FAFSA Code is 002099.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Admissions merit-based scholarships are competitive and are awarded based on academic rigor and a holistic review process of your submitted credentials. To be considered, students must complete an admissions application by the Nov. 15 Early **Action Deadline.**
