This talk discusses Aeschylus' 5th c. BCE play *Prometheus Bound* and its performance at the 1927 and 1930 Delphic Festivals organized by the American heiress Eva Palmer-Sikelianos and her husband, the Greek poet Angelos Sikelianos. At a time when a sense of origin continues to invigorate political struggles over geographic landscapes, this presentation provides a timely meditation upon the potential and the limits of landscape to be mapped to a spiritual or political project.
