#### **Director's Note**

#### **About the Play:**

Almost, Maine is a play about love - not the sentimental flowers and chocolates and everything-will-be-perfect-in-two-hours kind of love. It is about the magic of a first kiss. It is about finding love and losing love. About closing the door on one love and the possibility of opening a new door - or not. It is about love at first sight and about realizing what you have been looking for is right in front of you - and all the joys and fears and hope and hurt that go along with these revelations.

It has been referred to as "A Mid-Winter's Night Dream", and in many ways, it is. The magic of the Aurora Borealis might be the cause of the strange things that may (or may not) have happened in *Almost, Maine* on a clear, cold Friday night not too long ago.

This production looks a little different from other productions you have seen. I would like to thank playwright John Cariani for giving us the freedom to make his play work with this particular group of actors.

#### **About Directing during Covid:**

Directing a play with so many actors at this particular time means accepting challenges and coming up with some creative choices. These are ours.

**Understudies:** Many of the actors in this production learned their roles, as well as serving as an understudy for other roles. They created a character, learned lines, blocking and attended rehearsals for a role that might never been seen by anyone outside the cast. There were times when an understudy was out and another actor stepped in as an understudy for the understudy!

**Kissing:** Portraying love in 2022 is quite different from portraying love in the pre-COVID era. *Almost, Maine* is a collection of love stories—many of which involve life-changing kisses. To keep everyone healthy, we are using a combination of hugs, a few strategically placed kisses, and if necessary, the placement of touching hands as a placeholder. And the sound of a bell. So, when you hear a bell know someone's just been kissed.
