## **Notes:**

- 1. Students admitted to the Honors College with 60+ credits will have Honors ENGL, Honors TSEM, and one lower-level Honors course waived. FYE Freshman with 60+ credits should take either TSEM 190 or ENGL 290.
- 2. Internal transfers who have taken TSEM 102 at Towson (less than 30 credits) > TSEM waived, add one lower-level Honors course.
- $3. \quad \textit{Students who satisfy Honors English with ENGL 290 may take ENGL 290 a second time towards this requirement, as long as they do not repeat ENGL 290 with the same topic.}$

Requirements for Good Academic Standing and continuation in the Honors College (HC):

- 1. Cumulative 3.0 GPA in all courses (89 credits and below).
- 2. Cumulative 3.2 GPA in all courses (90+ credits).
- 3. Cumulative 3.3 GPA in all courses upon graduation.
- 4. Cumulative 3.0 GPA in all HC courses at all times.
- 5. End of First Year: successfully complete 6 HC units.
- 6. End of Second Year: successfully complete 12 HC units.
- 7. End of Third Year: successfully complete 18 HC units.
- \* Students who fall below the requirements for good standing will be placed on Honors Probation for at least one semester and will become academically ineligible to participate in the Honors College if they fail to return to good standing by the end of the probationary period.
