- 5. Course Name/Number/Section
- 6. Supporting Documentation (Medical, Legal, etc.)

Appeal Letters:

Letters must be written by the student, not a third party. They should be brief, concise, typed and include documentation (i.e. Medical documentation on letterhead including dates of treatment). Electronic submission via PDF is preferred. A sample of an appeal letter can be found at ASC Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's).
